

HANDBOOK Amendment

Progress reports will be used to communicate student attendance. Total accumulated absences will be printed on each progress report. When a student accumulates 5 UNEXCUSED absences, a detailed absence report will be sent home with the child at the following progress report. The progress reports are given out every 3rd and 6th week of a nine week grading period.

When the student reaches seven UNEXCUSED absences, there will be an attendance support team meeting with the parent/guardian, the student, the grade level counselor, and a building administrator. The TAADRA law will be outlined during the meeting explaining that a student's license will be suspended if and when the student reaches ten UNEXCUSED absences.
